

SPECIFIC TASKS OR OBJECTIVES:

- Recommend to the City Council golf resort improvements, marketing, and capital projects as it relates to the Indian Wells Golf Resort
- Recommend to the City Council overall general maintenance of facility
- Recommend to the City Council improvements in service while dining or the selection of food and beverage on the menu as well as customer relations as it relates to the IW Club restaurant

COMPOSITION: The Golf Resort Advisory Committee consists of ten (10) members with voting authority: the general managers from the Hyatt Regency, Indian Wells Resort Hotel, Miramonte Resort, Renaissance Esmeralda Resort, and the Golf Resort at Indian Wells; five (5) residents; and two (2) non-voting City Council members. Resident members must be registered Indian Wells voters and must maintain residency within the City of Indian Wells for the duration of their term to serve on the Golf Resort Advisory Committee.

TERM: The resident members serve staggered two year terms commencing on July 1. A two term limit applies.

MEETING DATE: Meets on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. in the Executive Conference Room.
