



JOSLYN SENIOR CENTER BOARD OF DIRECTORS

DESCRIPTION: Incorporated in 1981 as a non-profit corporation, the Joslyn Senior Center has helped seniors in Indian Wells, Rancho Mirage and Palm Desert to remain independent and active. The current center was built in 1984 through Community Development Block Grant funds and a donation from the Joslyn Family Foundation.

The Center is funded in part through the Cove Communities Service Commission, which is comprised of representatives from the three cities we serve; Indian Wells, Rancho Mirage and Palm Desert. The remaining funds are raised through membership dues, program fees, room rentals, special events, grants, individual donations and interest income from the endowment fund.

The 15-member Board of Directors is responsible for setting policy for the Center and insuring that such policies are carried out. In addition, the Board is responsible for exercising the powers of the Center, controlling its property, seeking funding, and conducting its affairs.

QUALIFICATIONS: The resident member must be registered voter and must maintain residency within the City of Indian Wells for the duration of their term to serve on the Joslyn Senior Center Board of Directors.
