SPECIFIC TASKS OR OBJECTIVES:

- Advises the Palm Springs City Council on various matters related to the airport including acquisition, development, financing and lease arrangements, present and future airport operations, and budget

COMPOSITION: The Airport Commission is comprised of nineteen members representing each city in the Coachella Valley and the private sector.

TERM: The Indian Wells resident recommended to the Palm Springs City Council for appointment to the Airport Commission serves a two year term commencing on July 1 and must be a registered Indian Wells voter and must maintain residency within the City of Indian Wells for the duration of their term to serve on the Airport Commission. A two term limit applies.

MEETING DATE: Meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 8:00 a.m. Meetings are held on the second floor of the terminal building at the Palm Springs International Airport.

CONFLICT DISCLOSURE: Palm Springs Regional Airport Commission members are required to complete and file an annual Statement of Economic Interests, Form 700, with the Palm Springs City Clerk.
