Considering Resolution Establishing Fees for Residential Indoor Marijuana Cultivation (RIMC) Permitting.

This action has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the State and local CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. The proposed Resolution will have no significant effect on the environment and qualifies as being Categorical Exempt from CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) (the activities will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment), 15060(c)(3) (the activities are not "projects" as defined in Section 15378) of the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, because there is no potential for resulting in physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly and 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, because it can be seen with certainty that it will not have a significant effect or physical change to the environment.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the City Council at or prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. According to Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge the Council's action in court or at an administrative proceeding, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City, either at or prior to the public hearing.
