

## **Requirements for Fire Pits, Fireplaces and BBQs**

 All fire pits, fireplaces and BBQs must have a United Laboratory Listing (U.L. Listing) or a listing by an approved testing agency and must be approved by the Building Officer/Fire Marshall. All installations must adhere to the manufacturer's specifications.

FIRE PITS	
	Must be 15 feet from any structure or other combustible material (2010 CFC 307.4. Exception: Fires in approved containers that are not less than 15 feet (4572 mm) from a structure.
	Must be 5 feet from any property line (ZC 21.20.140).
	Fire pits cannot be installed under any type of ceiling or overhang.

## FIREPLACES – FREE STANDING/MUNICIPAL CODE 21.20.140

Must be 5 feet minimum from any combustible (front of firebox when an extension of house, courtyard, etc.)

Must be 5 feet from any property line.

May encroach 30 inches into required setback no more than 30 inches (ZC 21.20.100).

## BBQS

Outdoor BBQ heating/cooking surfaces shall be located a minimum of 5 feet from any habitable structure, unless authorized by the Building Official (ZC 21.20.140).

Must be 10 feet from combustibles (exposed wood).
