Construction Updates In Indian Wells

Many projects are underway in the City:

- Repaving of Cook St. from Highway 111 to Fred Waring Dr.
- New black top coating of various streets.
- Design phase to restripe Fairway Dr. from Cook St. to Eldorado Dr. to slow down traffic.
- Design phase to add turn pockets on Highway 111 for motorists turning right (northbound & southbound) onto Eldorado Dr.
- Community Garden redesign and construction to better accomodate residents with limited mobility (see photo).
- Increase screening wall surrounding the City's Maintenance Yard.
- Received grant funding for installation of electric vehicle charging stations at City Hall and the Indian Wells Golf Resort.

- Awarded state grant from CalRecycle to use rubberized asphalt to reduce traffic noise.

- New concrete pads and handicap ramps to improve accessibility at 8 bus stops along Highway 111 (see photo).




Fire Station #55 Renovation

Fire Station #55 is currently undergoing significant structural upgrades and interior improvements. The entire fire station was retrofitted to enhance the safety of the building during an earthquake.

The interior of the fire station was also improved with new dorm rooms, renovation of the restrooms and gym facility. Construction is to be complete in early September.


