

## Indian Wells Golf Resort

### Political Activities Policy

#### A. Purpose

The public and common areas of the Indian Wells Golf Resort are intended to facilitate the normal flow of traffic of all its users, visitors and their guests and to promote the sole use of the facility for recreational and community enrichment activities.

#### B. Prohibited Political Activities

No political or commercial activity (other than operations of the Indian Wells Golf Resort itself or its operator's vendors) shall be permitted in any public or common areas of the Indian Wells Golf Resort, including exterior or interior entryways, hallways, lobbies, restaurants, cafés, lounges, patios, bars, and other spaces of that nature. This policy does not preclude the renting of any of these areas for a political or commercial use in accordance with and subject to the rental requirements and conditions otherwise applicable to the renting of space in the Indian Wells Golf Resort. Political activities, as defined below, do not include (1) spontaneous personal and individual conversations between users, guests and/or visitors who consent to participate in such a discussion and (2) the unorganized wearing of clothing containing words which might otherwise constitute political activity, so long as the wearing of such clothing is not planned or coordinated with other persons wearing such clothing at the Golf Resort.

Political activities shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (A) any activity that relates to the election or defeat of any candidate or potential candidate for public office or ballot measure;
- (B) any activity undertaken to influence the passage, defeat or revision of any local, state or federal legislation or policy;
- (C) any activity related to voter registration;
- (D) any activity related to political lobbying;
- (E) any activity related to collecting or soliciting political contributions;
- (F) any activity related to making political speeches, recruiting for political meetings or rallies, or distributing political literature; and
- (G) soliciting guests or employees of the Indian Wells Golf Resort, whether directly or indirectly, to work or engage in any of the activities listed above.

C. Trespassing

Any person violating any of the foregoing prohibitions or restrictions shall be reported to the proper officials as trespassing and shall be subject to a violation of Chapter 9.58.020 (k) of the Indian Wells Municipal Code.

D. Lawful Activities

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any informational event or activity hosted or sponsored by the City of Indian Wells, as otherwise permitted by law, may be undertaken by the City of Indian Wells. The foregoing policy is adopted in accordance with Government Code section 3207.
