# THE CITY OF INDIAN WELLS PRESENTS: SECOND INDIAN WELLS PRO-AM INVITATIONAL!

Only a few spots remain for the much-anticipated Indian Wells Pro-Am Invitational, to be held February 5 and 6, 2016 at the Indian Wells Golf Resort, with an 11 a.m. February 5 shotgun start.

Teams for this second annual golf event will consist of one professional and four amateurs or members, playing in a two best ball net Shamble Format. with food stations throughout the course area; Friday evening mixer and reception, and a delicious prime rib dinner during the Saturday evening awards ceremony.

The first lottery takes place January 20—22 for the Premier Finals Weekend;


The regular complimentary ticket lottery for all other sessions takes place February 8-12.


#### Winter Pre-Paid Card and Coachella Valley Resident Rates

## Protect Your Identity and Shred Sensitive Documents



Indian Wells residents are encouraged to bring obsolete documents as well as file folders and envelopes for secure shredding. It is not necessary to remove staples or paper clips.

### Just a few days remain for Christmas tree recycling

Burrtec Waste and Recycling will be collecting Christmas trees for recycling on your regular trash collection day, through the second week of January. Please remove all decorations and stands, cut trees in lengths not exceeding four feet, bind branches together, and place next to your trash and recycling carts. Flocked trees must also be cut into four-foot lengths and placed next to trash containers but, unfortunately, cannot be recycled and will be sent to the landfill. 


