# PLAY IN 20TH ANNUAL BNP PARIBAS OPEN SENIOR CUP

More than 700 players are expected to participate in this exciting team tennis doubles tournament. The BNP Paribas Open Senior Cup, which features men's and women's divisions in Seniors (50+) and Super Seniors (60+) age categories, will take place at several state-of-the-art courts and culminate in the March 21 finals to be held at the Indian Wells Tennis Garden.

Players enter as teams of six players plus substitutes with a minimum of seven players required. There are two groups for men and women based on NTRP rating.

Women: Seniors (50+) 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5 and Super Seniors (60+) 3.5, 4.0. Men: Seniors (50+) 3.5, 4.0, 4.5 and Super Seniors (60+) 3.5, 4.0.

> The entry fee is \$200 per player and includes a ticket to the 2013 BNP Paribas Open championship matches on Sunday, March 17, a kick-off breakfast on Monday, March 18, player reception on Wednesday, March 20, new balls for each match, courtside refreshments, and awards for finalists.

The \$200 entry fee deadline is March 3; \$225 per player. No entry fee refunds after


### Groove with the King on February 23!


