## DESERT HORIZONS PLANNED SIGN PROGRAM

The following are requirements for the Desert Horizons Planned Sign Program.

- (a) Upper Tier on Guard Structure. The half circle shaped logo shall be fabricated of one-quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ") aluminum. The background color shall be "Burlap" and the "mountains and sunrays" shall be "Gold" in color. The logo shall not exceed seventy inches (70") in length by thirty-seven inches (37") in height. It shall be stud mounted a half inch ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ") from the building face. The emblem shall not occupy more than eighteen (18) square feet of surface area.
- (b) Middle Tier on Guard Structure. The word "DESERT HORIZONS" shall be block style lettering and anodized bronze in color. It shall be fabricated of quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ") aluminum metal. The lettering shall not exceed seventeen and a half inches ( $\frac{17}{2}$ ") in height and shall not span more than a total of eighteen feet ( $\frac{18}{18}$ ) in length.
- (c) Bottom Tier on Guard Structure. The word "COUNTRY CLUB" shall be italicized style lettering and anodized bronze in color. It shall be fabricated of quarter inch ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ") aluminum metal. The uppercase letters shall be fifteen inches (15") in height. The lowercase lettering shall be ten inches (10") in height. The lettering shall span a total of nine feet nine inches (9' 9") in length. (Ord. 629 § 1, 2009)
