



Beginning July 1, 2010, residents may call *Burrtec Waste & Recycling Services* for free at-home collection of Household Hazardous Waste. **This program replaces the collection events held at City Hall.** Call (760) 340-2113 to schedule this free service. *Burrtec's* Customer Service staff will be happy to schedule a pick-up of your materials. Please do not place household hazardous waste at the curb. The material should be placed near your waste cans for collection. Hazardous wastes include: paint, oils, pesticides, cleaners, solvents, medication, sharps, fluorescent light bulbs/tubes, household batteries, auto batteries, chemicals, toner cartridges and similar products.

NOTE: Sharps may be placed in a plastic, sealable container such as a liquid laundry detergent bottle with a secure lid. Hazardous Waste labels are available for your sharps container at City Hall. For your privacy and identity protection, please black out or destroy labels on prescription medicine containers.
