



Number of People Answered this Question: 419







Speed Management

- Fairway Drive experiences cut-through traffic
- Local roads that need traffic calming:
 - Rancho Palmeras, Eldorado, Fairway
- Portola Ave speeding due to downhill slope
- Cielito Drive speeding
- Private vehicles and contractor vehicles



Active Transportation

- Install bike path
 - at end of Hwy 111, Rancho,
- Install sidewalks
 - Eldorado, and by Fairway Dr & Rancho Palmeras
- Midblock near Village Plaza (coffee shop/sprouts)
- Cars sticking out of driveways
- Take curve out and extend curb out for bike and pedestrians Fairway & Cahilla Dr



Aggressive Driving

- Crosswalk needed across Eldorado or possible traffic circle
- Calm streets for multiuse (ped, bikes, golf carts)







